

CCA 799/499 - Independent Studies

Independent Studies are voluntary agreements between individual faculty members and individual students, in which students complete original creative work or directed research. Since, Independent Study is intended to expand a student's work beyond the regular curriculum, it may not be used to duplicate course offerings.

In order to register for the course, students must:

- 1) Seek the agreement of a faculty mentor, complete the Independent Study Contract
- 2) Secure the approval of the Department Chair prior to enrolling.

In order to receive a grade for this course, students must submit all the required materials to their faculty mentors by the last official day of classes in the semester in which they are enrolled. Faculty mentors must submit their grade to the Department Chair by the last official day of the semester in which the student enrolled.
